Our Supervisors are required to set achievable and realistic goals to maintain the required standard of environmental performance, taking compliance with legislation as the minimum standard. The implementation of policy, systems and procedures will be regularly reviewed to ensure that standards are being maintained.

Supervisors and staff throughout the Company will be encouraged to take a close and active interest in environmental issues in their particular areas of activity. Full consultation on environmental protection matters is encouraged at all levels. The Company encourages effective liaison on environmental issues with joint venture/consortium partners and a sense of shared responsibility for environmental protection amongst employees and subcontractors.

All members of the Company's Staff and Employees will be involved in the Environmental Policy through the following processes:

When planning Company work activities, the only matters that will be given priority above the protection of the environment are the health, safety and welfare of its Employees and others that may be affected by its activities.

The Company will wherever viable and consistent with its Client's instructions, use materials and products from sustainable sources that are re-useable or recyclable.
